The painting of Our Lady of Czestochowa is probably one of the best known images of Our Lady. The work's title originated with the establishment in a Polish town of the same name of a permanent home and shrine for the ancient icon of Mary. Tradition is that the picture of the majestic Mary and Jesus on her left arm, provided him with a throne from which to bless the world, was painted on a Cyprus panel that had been the table top used by the Holy Family at Nazareth.
